→ Degrees 3 प्रकार की होती हैं

① - Positive Degree. → एक ही (वस्तु, व्यक्ति, स्थान) की बात होती है

② - Comparative Degree. → दो की (हिस्सा) $\frac{1}{2}$ $\rightarrow$ $\frac{1}{3}$

③ - Superlative Degree. $\rightarrow$ $\frac{1}{4}$ $\rightarrow$ $\frac{1}{5}$ $\rightarrow$ $\frac{1}{6}$ $\rightarrow$ $\frac{1}{7}$

Degree

① Positive Degree →

वह एक अच्छा लड़का है
He is a good boy.

② Comparative Degree!

राम मोहन से अच्छा है
Ram is better than Mohan

③ Superlative Degree →

राम गांव का सबसे बुरिमास लड़का है
Ram is the worst boy of the village.

Formation of the Comparative and the Superlative

Rule 1 एक syllable वाले और कुछ दो syllable वाले Adjectives की Positive form में 'er' जोड़ कर Comparative बनता है और 'est' जोड़कर Superlative बनता है।

Rule 2 जब Positive form ' e ' से समाप्त होती है तो क्रमशः केवल ' r ' तथा 'st' add किया जाता है।

<u>Large</u>	<u>larger</u>	<u>largest</u>
<u>Brave</u>	<u>braver</u>	<u>bravest</u>
<u>Fine</u>	<u>finer</u>	<u>finest</u>
<u>Wise</u>	<u>wiser</u>	<u>wisest</u>

Rule 3 जब Positive form ' y ' से समाप्त होती है और उससे पहले consonant आता है, तो 'er' और 'est' लगाने से पहले ' y ' को ' i ' में change कर देते हैं।

Positive	Comparative	Superlative
Heavy	heavier	heaviest
Easy	easier	easiest
Happy	happier	happiest
Lazy	lazier	laziest
Wealthy	wealthier	wealthiest

Rule 4 यदि एक Syllable वाला शब्द single consonant से समाप्त होता है और उससे पहले Vowel आता है, तो अंतिम consonant (व्यंजन) double हो जाता है।

Positive	Comparative	Superlative
Big	bigger	biggest
Fat	fatter	fattest
Hot	hotter	hottest
Sad	sadder	saddest

Rule 5 दो से अधिक syllable वाले अधिकतर adjectives की (Positive form) में 'more' लगाकर comparative form तथा 'most' लगाकर superlative form बनाई जाती है।
