# Principles of Helping Pupils with Learning Difficulties


Some important principles which will help a language teacher to deal with students with learning difficulties are

#### 1. Teaching Preparation

defore preparing their lessons, teachers shouldn't we'lt identify pupils' diverse learning needs as soon as possible so that they may design appropriate teaching plans to facilitate pupils' effective learning.

### 2. Devise Various Learning Activities

Teachers must devise different learning activities with the same teaching objective to develop pupils' varied abilities and skills in problem-solving.





Pupils with learning difficulties are less competent in understanding written language. Therefore, teachers should give pupils short and clear instructions to

#### Summarise the Main Points

In the course of teaching, teachers should always sum up the main points in teaching and write the key phrases on the board to enhance pupils' audio and visual memories. Teachers can guide their pupils to link up the knowledge they learn from class with their life experiences so as to enhance the effectiveness of learning.

## Enhance Learning Interest and Motivation

Pupils' with learning difficulties may lose their interest in learning. Therefore, teachers should adapt the curriculum to meet the needs of pupils.

### Strategies of Remedial Teaching

To fulfill the learning needs of individual pupils, the Individualised Educational Program (IEP) aims to reinforce the foundation of learning, help pupils overcome their learning difficulties and develop their potentials.


